

RE: Public Notice – Informing Local Residents of Upcoming Construction

The Pemiscot County Commission wishes to inform local residents of the future demolition of county road bridge 249, followed immediately by construction to replace said bridge. During which time that the bridge shall be demolished and new bridge will be constructed, the route connected by the bridge will be disconnected, and thus detour approximately 6.0 miles long on Route B and county road 244 will be necessary during construction.

This bridge is located north of Wardell on county road 249 and little river drainage ditch. The new bridge will replace the existing box culvert.

The Pemiscot County Commission hereby extends an invitation to local residents affected by the replacement of this bridge. From this present date of July 15, 2026 until July 29, 2026 citizens are welcome to submit comments or concerns in relation to the replacement of the county road 249 to the Pemiscot County Commission.

The Pemiscot County Commission will take into consideration all relevant submissions and, if deemed necessary and appropriate by the Commission, will consider further action in relation to this project. Plans will be available upon request.
